

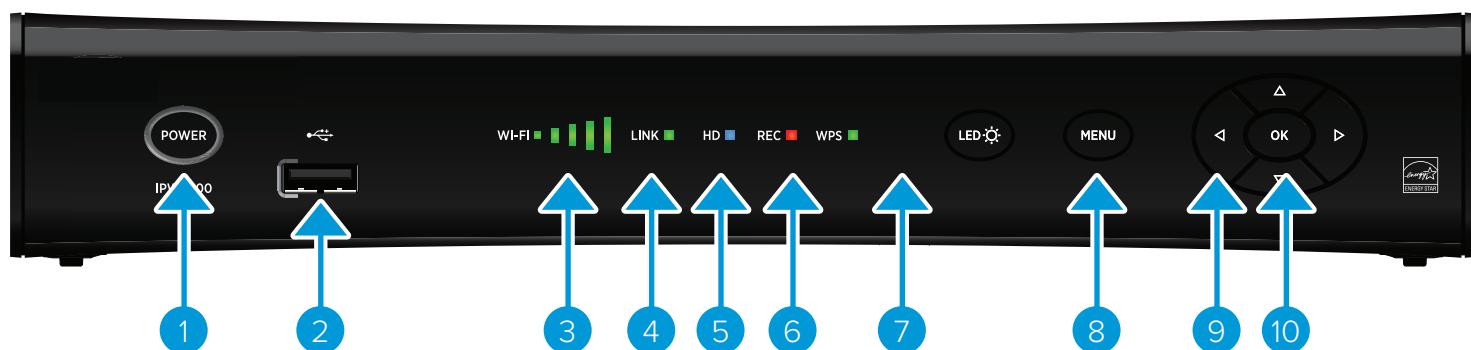


pairing instructions

- 1 Connect wireless set-top box to power and wait until a prompt appears asking you to connect.
- 2 Press OK on the wireless set-top box.
- 3 Go to the RG, press and release the WPS button 3 times to activate the WPS Process.
- 4 The light next to WPS will blink ORANGE.
- 5 A gear icon will appear indicating the connection sequence is in progress.
- 6 When three horizontal dots appear, the connection has been successful.
- 7 On the front pane of the wireless set-top box, two or more LEDs on the signal strength indicator will light-up GREEN.



wireless set-top box



1 POWER
Turns the set-top box on or places it in standby. To restart, press and hold the POWER button for 10 seconds. The LED lights green when on.

2 USB PORT
USB connector. (Reserved for future use)

3 SIGNAL STRENGTH INDICATOR
Identifies the strength of the wireless connection.

4 LINK
Indicates network link status. The light is green.

5 HD
Indicates the set-top box is set to an HD resolution. The light is blue.

6 RECORD
Indicates that a recording is in progress. The light is red.

7 IR SENSOR
Receives the infrared signal from the remote control. The sensor is behind the front panel.

8 MENU
Accesses the on-screen menu.

9 ARROW KEYS
Access on-screen services & navigate menus.

10 OK
Selects the current item.
